OFFICIAL:

The following rules are officially in effect for 2019-2020
season and permissively in effect for 2020-2021 season:

TEAM NEWS: No new business...

League Structure: 2019 Season: Summerwood residents only. 1 Division 14 Teams.
13 Week regular season.

2020: NO CHANGE

Bench: 2018 Season: Bench size 5 + IR

***NEW** - IR: If Player occupying an IR spot, comes 'active' and is not moved to 'Bench' by Wednesday you MUST drop IR player from ROSTER. (Midnight)

***NEW** - 2019: IR PUNISHMENT (PASSED, 8 votes in favor)

2019: 5 + IR (5 + IR PASSED, 12 votes in favor)

Kicker: 2018 Season: Kicker was kept for 2018 season

2019: NO CHANGE (7/11 votes in favor to keep kicker)

Keeper Players: **2019 Season:** Keepers were voted in beginning in 2018.

2019: (KEEPERS STAY, 12 votes in favor)

2019: Keeper with 'compensation' was passed for 2019 season

- A player is only eligible as keeper if drafted and retained by your team the entire season and throughout playoffs
- Keepers identified and announced prior to next year's draft with deadline date determined by next commissioner
- Keeper compensation is the amount the player was drafted for in 2018-2019

NEW Keeper rules unanimously passed for 2019 season

- **Keeper Value Establishment:** The amount a player is drafted for, establishes player keeper value. For example: If Aaron Rogers is drafted for \$70 in 2018, the keeper value for 2019 (1st year keeper) is \$70.
- **Keeper Eligibility:** Any drafted player.
- Any drafted player added from waivers or acquired by trade...can be identified as a keeper for the following year
- Players added to roster after the trade deadline are not keeper eligible
- Player cannot be a keeper if player was undrafted (reiterate)

- 1st year keeper value is set by previous year's draft amount
- Keeper players acquired by trade or from waiver wire add: +\$10/year
- **Keeper Value (if traded):** 1st year draft price, 2nd year +\$10, 3rd year +\$10...etc added to original keeper (drafted) value
- If traded after 1st year, the keeper's value carries with player to new owner
- For example: If player is selected as keeper for 2019 season, player is kept as a keeper for 2020 season, that player's value now equals the 2019 draft value + \$10 (2nd season). IF that player is then traded to another owner/team in 2020 season and the new owner wants to designate as a keeper for 2021 season, that player's value equals 2019 draft value + \$10 (2nd season) + \$10 (3rd season) and so on. This keeps parity across keepers
- Once a designated keeper does not end the year on a roster or is not drafted the following year, their keeper status and value resets at next draft

Free Agent / Waiver Wire: 2018: Free Agent Auction Budget (FAAB) was passed. \$100 budget, \$1 min bid, blind bids (submit your highest bid for player) and FAAB order resets each week to inverse order of standings. Waiver period is 1 day.

2019: NO CHANGE

Trades: 2018: Switched from a 'committee' to a full league vote. 8 votes to veto a trade, 24 hours to vote (veto) or trade will auto-process and approve. *Any player involved in a trade cannot play because deadline was missed for that week, that trade cannot go through until the following week. Current owners can still use those players until the trade processes the following week. Trade acceptance deadline is 6:50pm Wednesday's in order to be eligible to play a 7:00pm Thursday night game.

Trade Deadline: 2018 Season: Week 10 – Wednesday, 12PM EST

2019: NO CHANGE – Week 10: Wednesday 12:00PM EST

*Billy Baber makes a motion to match trade deadline equal to NFL trade deadline date...motion did not carry

Point Structure: 2018 Season: DEF point settings were changed to attempt to limit DEF from negative points, if possible.

2019: NO CHANGE

Weekly Head to Head Results: 2018: Renamed the “Skinner Rule”. Vote passed to abolish this rule indefinitely. (REMOVED)

2019: NO CHANGE

Weekly High Score: 2018: Vote passed to abolish this rule indefinitely. (REMOVED)

2019: NO CHANGE

Playoff Seats: 2018 Season: Top 8 in SWFF belt playoffs and bottom 6 in Toilet Bowl

2019: NO CHANGE (8/12 votes in favor to keep Top 8)

Playoff Structure: 2018: Top 8 in SWFF belt playoffs and Bottom 6 in Toilet Bowl

- Playoffs: Week 14, Week 15 and Week 16
- Playoff eligibility determined by win/loss record
- Playoff seeding determined by win/loss record
- Equal win/loss record seeding, tie breaker is total ‘Points For’ at regular season end
- If total Points For are tied, next tie breaker is head-to-head result
- No bye week for #1 or #2 seed overall seeds
- Super Bowl is week 16, one week for the belt

2019: NO CHANGE

Toilet Bowl: 2018 Season: \$20 mandatory buy in, side pot and separate from SWFF total money pool. Money to be collected by Co-Commissioner in form of CASH 1 week before playoff. If you fail to pay before week 1 of playoffs will result in a forfeit of your Toilet Bowl playoffs and still obligated to pony up \$20. Winner take all. 6 owners = \$120 payout.

2019: NO CHANGE

FINANCIALS:

Initial Buy In: 2018 Season: \$220

2019: NO CHANGE – Additional funds support award maintenance and remainder used for Super Bowl/Chill cookoff party

\$220 BUY IN Breakdown: \$200 player commitment, \$20 goes to award maintenance and Super Bowl/Chili cookoff party

Supporters Shield (SS) Winner: 2018 Season: \$200, Total Points For at the end of the regular season. Money comes from SWFF pool (\$2,800).

2019: Vote passed to increase to \$400. \$200 supplemented from 4th place payout (vote carried 9/12 in favor)

SUPER BOWL PAYOUT: 2019 Season: **\$2,800 total pot**

Supporters Shield Winner: **\$400**

- SB4 Champion: **\$1,300**
- 2nd Place: **\$700**
- 3rd Place: **\$400**
- ~~4th Place: \$200~~

Banner / Walk of Shame: 2018 Season: Lowest regular season 'Points For'

*Brian makes a motion to change to overall regular season record for Banner (3/12 votes, motion does not carry)

2019: NO CHANGE

2018 Length of Stay: 30-day Banner Punishment – License Plate frame must be on a family vehicle (your daily driver) until next year's draft!

*Motion to change length of stay the banner must be displayed from 30 days to 90 days starting from the banner walk ceremony date.

(2019: PASSED, 9/12 votes in favor)!!!
